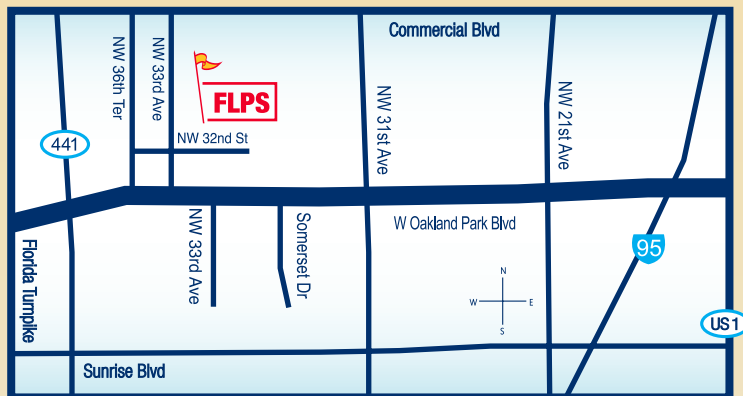

- An excellent opportunity to earn extra credits and get ahead academically

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## About our Summer School

Summer School 2015 begins on Friday, June 19, 2015. School will be 5 days per week, Monday through Friday.

For students in grades 5-12, each session will consist of 60 hours of classroom instruction. School will be 6 hours per day, 5 days per week, Monday through Friday.

Attendance is mandatory. Students must arrive promptly. Missed time must be made up after school.

To enroll in FLPS Summer School to repeat a previously taken class - all students in Grades 5-12 are required to bring a letter from their current school specifying course(s) required and their 2014/2015 report card.

High school students may earn up to 2 credits for repeated\* classes based on successful completion of 120 hours of instruction, per 4 week session. Or, 1 credit based on successful completion of 60 hours of instruction per 2 week session.

\* Repeated course constitutes a course that was previously taken on the high school level and failed.

High school students may earn up to 1 credit based on successful completion of 120 hours of instruction during a four week session, if advancing\*\* in a subject.

\*\* Advanced course constitutes a new course - one that has never been taken on the high school level.

FLP is a fully accredited academic institution. All classes and credits are transferable to all schools; public, private or parochial.

## Grade K-4 (8:30 am to 11:30 am)

Our K-4 summer school program consists of intensive math and reading review, teaching, listening, following directions and attention span drills. Students are released at 11:30 am so they can participate in outside (parent provided) summer camp programs.

## Grade 5-12 (8:30 am to 2:30 pm)

Summer school will be comprised of two sessions. Students may attend one or both. Those students who wish to improve academic skills, complete credits, or advance in subjects for the next year may attend. Skills classes in Reading, Language Arts, Math, Study Skills Techniques, and SAT Prep will be offered as well as most major subjects.

## Dates

**Session I:** 6/19 - 7/2 (10 days, 6 hours per day)

**Session II:** 7/6 - 7/17 (10 days, 6 hours per day)

## Fees for Sessions I & II

Grade K-4: \$550 per session; 8:30 am - 11:30 am (3 hours per day)

Grades 5-8: \$700 per session (non-credit)

Grades 9-12: \$750 per session (credit)

Enrollment is limited. We maintain a low student/teacher ratio to maximize student success.
